

NP meeting 22 April 2014

Attendees: Dave Roberts, Tessa Lanstein, Andrew Bennett, Gary Sumner, Colin Offer and PX Warensjo

1. First half of the meeting spent talking about what a Neighbourhood plan is, why we are doing it and the benefits we can get out of it. We also discussed the approved neighbourhood area and why the area was chosen.
2. Dave and Tessa handed over several printouts of material from Parish plan and Dave promised to give PX a cd/memory stick with all information that was gathered during the Parish plan process. Dave will also hand over Parish plan budget details.
3. Next steps will be a presentation during AGM and a neighbourhood forum meeting, preferably in first half of July. A lot of discussions took place of the best way to re-engage the villagers. Tessa and Dave suggested a forum with a number of stalls in Village halls where we have a number of tables, describing what neighbourhood plan is, showing the output from the parish plan and ask the participants if any changes/updates are needed.

Other items to consider

- Make sure the forum is well publicised in advance, flyers, Lyden Magazine, posters during May Day fare.
- Clarify what Neighbourhood plan is (development and use of land, not only new houses but community facilities, open spaces, cycle/walk paths, historic buildings, woodland, nature corridors etc)
- Point out what can be achieved with the Neighbourhood plan
- Get more people involved
