SBC's Strategic Housing and economic land availability assessment (SHELAA) and "call for sites"

SBC have now released their "initial site assessment" for all the SHELAA sites across Swindon.

Also attached is a spreadsheet showing SBC's "interim findings" and notes on each SHELAA site providing reasons as to why each site has been either "accepted" or "rejected".

If you want to raise any comments on the initial assessment then comments need to be sent to forwardplanning@swindon.gov.uk by **5pm Monday 12th November**, clearly indicating the site reference number. Please note that this is only an initial review of the SHELAA sites there will be a further 6 week consultation period on the final SHELAA sites in spring 2019.
