The development by virtue of its siting, scale, form, design and extent fails to deliver high quality design and would result in an unjustified encroachment into the open countryside. It would compromise the non-coalescence area and fail to respect and conserve the natural and historic environment, surrounding character and context, and landscape character. The development is unsuitable for the location and therefore fails to comply with Policies SD1, SD2, DE1, EN5 and NC3 of the adopted Swindon Borough Local Plan 2026 and National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF).
