Hooper's Field Committee Report – Colin Offer

All Wanborough clubs achieved a full diary of sports and social activities in the year 2022/23.

The Tennis club has maintained its increased memberships, and has successfully fundraised 50% of the cost to replace the existing floodlights on courts 1 & 2 with LED lights.

Wanborough Junior football club has increased in size again and will now manage eleven boys team with another six girls' teams expected to sign up; some of these teams will play at Hooper's Field.

Wanborough bowls club will maintain the green and purchase equipment suitable for the project, in order to reduce its expenses.

Wanborough adult cricket club will play two teams in the coming season, and has a membership which also includes thirty-five junior players.

In addition, 'Park Yoga' organised by the Parish Clerk will commence on Sunday the 7th May from 9.30am to 10.30am, this will be weekly activity until September.

The sports field now has a dog on leads policy in order to improve players' safety and users' well-being. There is signage on the field related to this and the public have been informed.

A break-in occurrence caused significant damage; the police attended and recommended CCTV to be installed - this will appear shortly and WIFI will also be available.

The driveway potholes problem continues to be an ongoing issue, and temporary infills are ongoing.
